

The DimiCare Training Course

In the last months the DimiCare partnership has dedicated their efforts to develop the DimiCare training course, a flexible, modular and low-threshold training course aimed at improving the digital skills of home helpers and care assistants. The training consists of 5 modules, each designed to address crucial aspects of digital literacy in the context of care:

- Basic digital competences
- Care-Specific Technology
- Application of Digital Tools
- Supporting Clients in the Use of Technology
- Data Protection

Currently the training course is tested across the 4 partner countries – Austria, Italy, Netherlands and Denmark- in their respective national languages. Care workers and trainers are asked to provide feedback and suggestions for improving the content, relevance and usability of the course.
