## ICT at School

### Applying ICT in Class

Educational authorities increasingly see the need to plan and deliver classes supported by new media to help teach in a stimulating and pleasant way.

Using computers in a secure environment, employing video beamers, using e-learning platforms and virtual school networks, are just a few examples of applying ICT in class. Using these techniques demands technological know-how at different levels.

Using ICT means moving beyond new presentation techniques – it implies a change and enhancement of teaching methodologies.

### A Continuing Education Programme

Within the ICTeacher programme teachers can acquire new as well as enhance their existing competences in the use of ICT in teaching and learning. Participants learn a wide range of didactical models and available teaching and learning materials to develop the range of their existing teaching methodologies.

## ICTeacher Objectives

The project aims at promoting the use of ICT in primary and secondary school classes. ICTeacher, the consortium, addresses the need for an appropriate ICT qualification system for school teachers. The quality of teaching and learning will be improved, and the professional opportunities of teachers will be increased by

- Raising awareness for the need and the advantages of adequate implementation of ICT elements in school lessons.
- Strengthening of teachers basic ICT competencies.
- Developing a course offer for the acquisition of ICT competencies for the pedagogical practice.
- Accreditation of the course as a European standard ICT qualification for school teachers.

### Target Group: Experienced Teachers

The main target group are teachers aged 40+ or those with more than 20 years of teaching experience but who have little experience of using ICT in the learning process. This group includes most teachers in Europe.

## ICTeacher Products

The main product of ICTeacher is a blended learning training course consisting of three main parts:

- Assessment of existing competencies and identification of training needs
- ICTeacher course consisting of four modules and
- Exam tests.

The ICTeacher programme will be developed in cooperation with ECDL accreditation organisations in the partner countries. The ICTeacher programme is committed to achieving accreditation as ECDL foundation endorsed project.
